

JAGUAR UNVEILLS FIRST EVER SUV

Most luxury brands offer at least one SUV in their line-up. Bentley very recently released their version,

the Bentayga The release by Jaguar surprised many market watchers as Tata has an SUV range with Land Rover. Called the F- Pace it will be built at the JLR plant in Solihull, Warwickshire which is the traditional home of Land Rover and the now defunct Rover cars.

The F-Pace will be offered in the USA with a choice of either a 380 or 340 horsepower V6 engine, both supercharged, or a 180 horsepower 4 cylinder diesel engine. All models will have an eight speed automatic transmission and full time all wheel drive system. The most powerful model ver-

sion will be capable of going 60 mph from a standing start in just over 5 seconds says Jaguar.

With the new XE sedan being introduced many dealerships who sell both Jaguar and

Land Rover will find it difficult to exhibit the full range of all products.


Driving directions from the Pennsylvania Turnpike:
