That night we took the car apart and back-flushed the radiator at a radiator shop who's owner opened his shop at 11:00 p.m., flushed the radiator and would not accept any payment for his time. We flushed out the block using the high pressure hose at the hotel which they used to clean out the garbage trucks. The next day we were on our way to Oklahoma City. Apparently we had picked up a nail while riding on the shoulder the previous day and had our first flat tire on I-40--in a pouring down rain, naturally. changed the tire in ten minutes and proceeded on to Fort Smith, our lunch stop. After lunch I asked Ralph to take over the driving as I was totally exhausted. (This was the only time during the race that we switched driving and navigating. It turned out, that once you got in the rhythm of navigating and/or driving it was not smart to change Again, we were traveling in pouring rain and a number of passing automobiles got a picture of me sound asleep in the passenger's seat of an open 1938 car traveling at 65 mph still on I-40.

That night's stop was Oklahoma City. We had seen the last of the rain. We left Oklahoma City for Dallas Saturday morning, July 1 and arrived in Dallas that afternoon. We had completed approximately half of the race--over 2,000 miles in six days of 12 to 14 hour days--in an open car and in the rain about half the time.

The third day from Charlotte to Knoxville was one of the worst; it rained very hard almost the entire day. The first accident ever in the Great American Race occurred in the mountains of North Carolina when a sedan lost control, ran off the road, vaulted a guard rail, hit a tree, and landed on its side. The driver and navigator were both hurt seriously enough to be taken to the hospital but they were released several days later. The car that crashed was a 1936 Lincoln which had belonged to President Franklin D. Roosevelt. The car was totalled. But we understand it is being rebuilt.

The fourth day from Nashville to Little Rock via Memphis was the only day we had real car problems. About 50 miles outside of Little Rock, scale which had built up in the engine block over the previous 50 years, broke loose clogging the radiator. We literally limped into Little Rock. The last 30 miles we drove on the shoulder of Interstate 40 at between 25 and 35 mph. Although we cleared every checkpoint, we were so late that the "finish line" had been dismantled and we had trouble convincing the officials that we were still in the race.


