



When replacing automobile light bulbs that are stubborn to remove, place a length of rubber tubing over the bulb. Be sure the tubing is a snug fit and sturdy enough so the walls will not collapse when turned to remove the bulb. Using this technique will protect your fingers from glass particles if the bulb breaks.

When tightening bleed nipples on wheel cylinders, do not over-tighten as they may shear or crack the alloy casting. Girling states that "a torque of 4 to 6 lbs. should be applied which is sufficient to lock the bleed screws up without damaging the orifices of the ports. If a tell-tale black ring is seen on the seating surface, this is a sure sign of over-tightening".

If you discover that your electric fuel pump is not pumping any fuel, strike it with the palm of your hand to jar the points into action.






