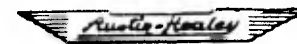

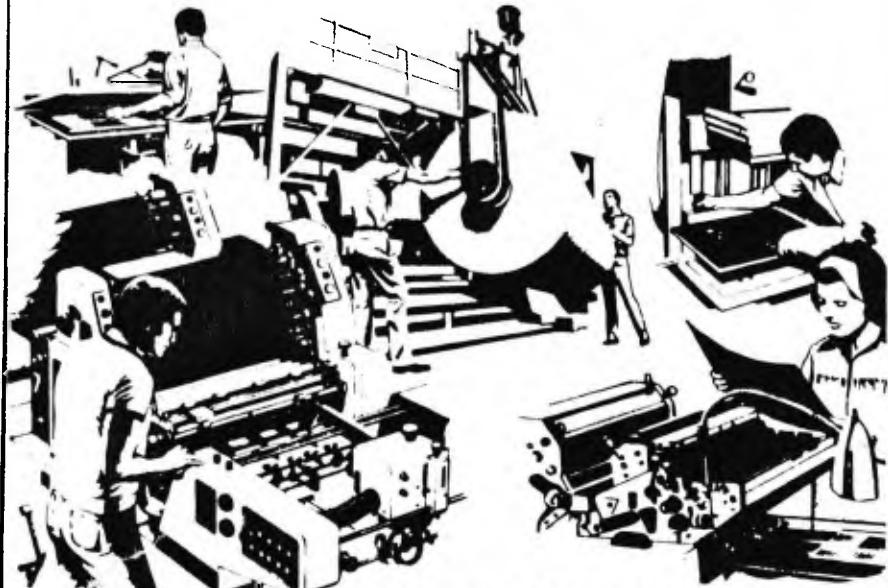

TIPS When reversing polarity (from positive to negative, of course), remember that the posts on the battery have different diameters. Swap the cable clamps in order to insure a tight fit. Thanx to Mike Wolf for this tip.

TIPS When replacing your exhaust system, stainless steel, in most cases, is the preferred material. In addition, it looks good and lasts almost forever. In replacing the silencers on my Mark X, I used a stainless steel system purchased from Dick Ames, who is one of our advertisers. The silencer meshed perfectly with the remaining mild steel system. The tubing and silencers are made from hyform 409 stainless steel with a 12% chromium content and the silencer cover and rear tip are made from Type 304 stainless steel with 18% chromium content. Service was prompt and courteous.

WHAT'S NEW

Rumor has it that the XJ6 sedans will be re-skinned in 1994 and the XJ-S will be further modernized in 1996. Mechanically they will be changed very little.

The "X200", a new, small Jaguar, following the lineage of the Mark II sedans of the 1950's, will debut in 1998. A sports car based on the X200 will be for sale by the year 2000.

The next new product from Coventry will be an XJ6 with a V-12 engine. This was promised by Sir John Egan in 1988, but adapting the V-12 to a narrow engine bay proved to be more difficult than anticipated.

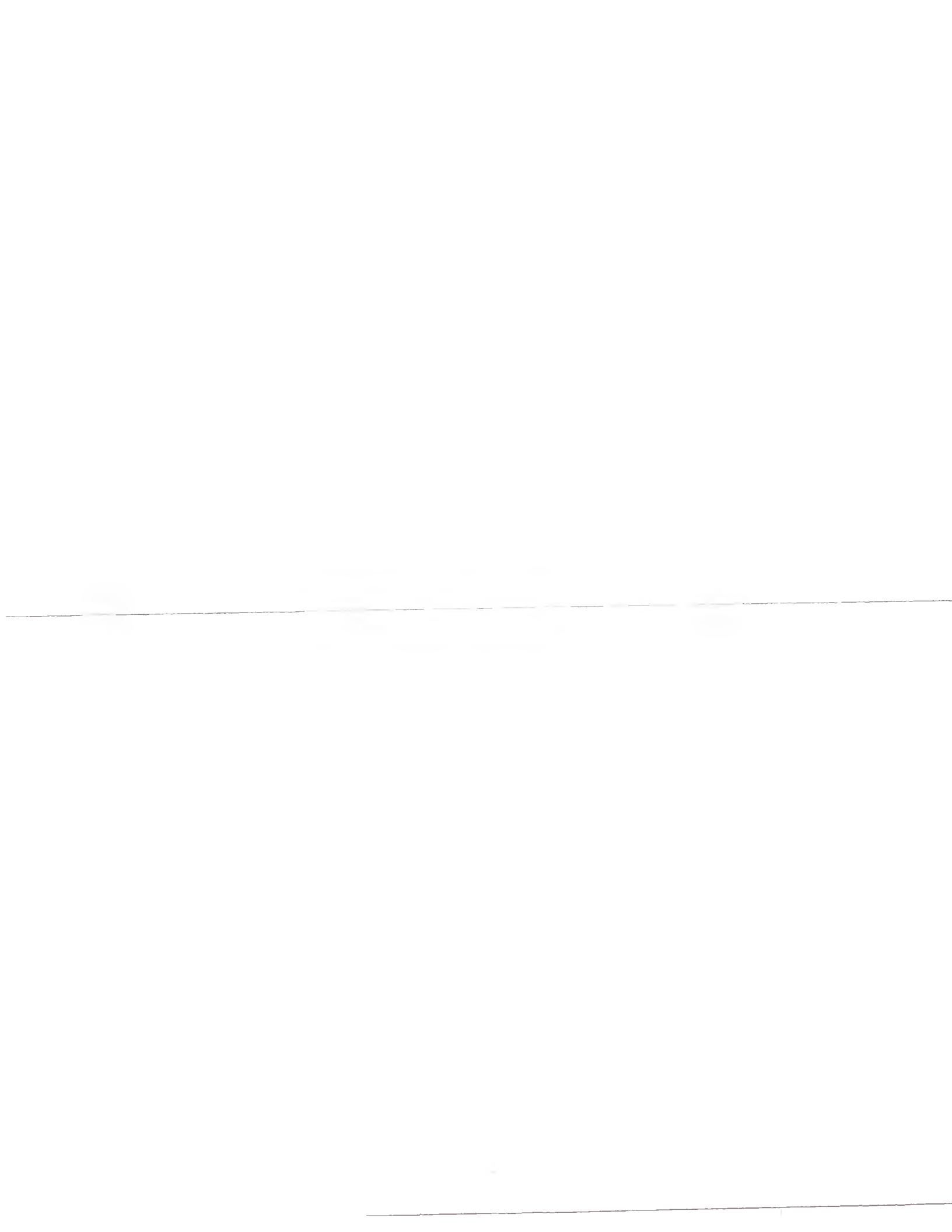
