

waterless hand cleaner. It will remove dirt, grease and unwanted undercoating from spark plug wires and wiring harnesses.

If you have a Jaguar with an automatic Borg-Warner transmission, allow it to idle in neutral gear for 10-20 seconds before driving off. This is important because in many cases the one-way valve that prevents fluid from draining from the torque converter may leak, causing the torque converter to drain itself. The car should idle in neutral because in these transmissions, the pump is not functioning in Park and therefore will not build up pressure to refill the converter. Thanx to Steve Kress.

Do not use transmission additives as these usually are diesel-based and may soften seals and degrade fiber-based materials in the transmission.


