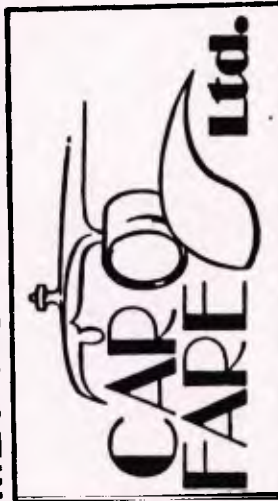

WHAT'S NEW



NEW EYES FOR THE CAT

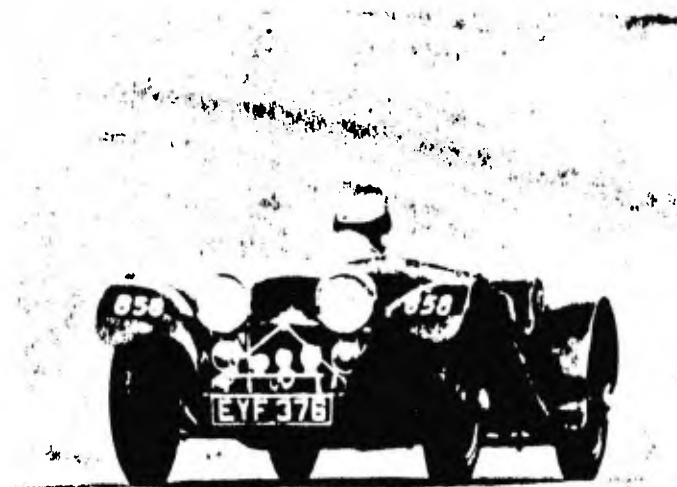
Jaguar is set to give its sedans a new look for the 1995 model year with extensive styling changes front and rear. As shown in this computer-enhanced photo of a prototype, the British automaker will revert to the dual round headlight arrangement, with hood and fender bulges to accent the look. A chrome grille will be the sole piece of brightwork.

January 10, 1994, Coventry, England -- *Jaguar* sales soared by 22 percent in 1993. The Coventry based luxury car manufacturer increased worldwide sales from 22,483 cars to 27,338 cars. Exports accounted for seventy seven percent (21,223 cars) of the company's total sales during the year.

Sales in *Jaguar's* biggest market, the United States, rose by 47 percent from 8,861 to 12,734. Continued growth throughout the year in the United States culminated in 1,376 sales in December -- *Jaguar's* best sales month of the year in this very competitive market.

Whilst much of Europe remains in recession, *Jaguar* saw sales grow in Austria (up 12 percent), Switzerland (up 11 percent) and Sweden (up 55 percent). In virtually every other European market, *Jaguar* saw a significant increase in its share of the luxury car sector.

Jaguar's Chairman and Chief Executive Nick Scheele commented. "There is no doubt that our excellent reputation for quality has been a major factor in our sales success in world markets."

 When removing a battery from the car, first remove the ground cable from its battery post. If the opposite wire is removed first, there is a possibility that a short circuit may occur if the wrench accidentally comes in contact with the body of the car.

 Silicone brake fluid contains three times the amount of dissolved air as does glycol brake fluid -- 15 percent versus 5 percent. Because of this, more pedal travel will be necessary to achieve the same amount of braking action that would occur on a glycol-based system.

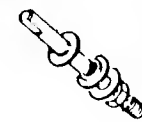
