



A new engine oil licensing and certification system will help dealers, suppliers and consumers recognize good products from poor ones. The American Petroleum Institute and the American Automobile Manufacturers Association have joined forces to create standards and tests for improving the quality of oil. The new symbol is a starburst and the program will begin July 1, 1994. New, higher standards of quality call for testing three to four times more samples than the 325 currently selected.

I feel that an important factor in having a good newsletter is to publish one that would be interesting to any Jaguar enthusiast no matter where he lives. This involves a lot of work in order to extract and compile information from other periodicals and magazines. From the feedback I have received, it seems that the favorites in our newsletter are Tip-Top-Tech-Tips and Tech Corner. It is somewhat difficult to continually produce new and interesting articles. I would like to thank Steve Kress for his contributions and assistance. I know that many of you out there have valuable and helpful information. Please, please contribute something so that the well does not run dry. Many of our articles are showing up in other Jaguar newsletters across the country, proving that emulation is the highest form of praise.

Editorially yours,

To paraphrase the old television show Sea Hunt, two-thirds of our car's interior is covered by leather yet how little we understand this world. Well, this is about to change! I am going to share some knowledge I have acquired in the process of working with leather in the restoration of two car interiors. This first lesson will introduce you to the language of "leatherese".

Grain: The natural pattern of wrinkles that creates the texture of the hide.

Full Grain: Leather in which the natural grain has not been mechanically altered.

Top grain: The uppermost layer of the hide. This is the highest-quality part of the hide.

Top full-grain: The uppermost layer of the hide in its natural condition without alterations to its grain pattern.

Premium select: The finest leather hide available, exhibiting few imperfections.

Splits: The underside of leather generally used for suedes.

Corrected grain leather: All hides have natural blemishes. These imperfections are buffed out and an artificial grain is embossed into the hide. This is the most economical leather and the sturdiest.

Aniline Leather: Leather that has been dyed with aniline dye. Only premium select top full-grain hides are dyed in this manner, which permeates the entire hide and results in a rich color.

Pigmenting: Coloring and coating the leather surface to cover imperfections and produce hides that are wearand fade- resistant.

Sauvage: A mottled appearance, resulting from blending similar colors, that adds depth to the hide.

Glazing: A top-coating that involves the application of transparent resins to the leather that produces a high-gloss or matte finish.

Patina: The luster or shine that develops on leather with time and use.

Drum Dyeing: Also known as vat dyeing. This process assures full dye penetration. The hides are immersed in dye and tumbled in a steel drum.

Hand: A leather industry term for the feel of the leather.




