Tech Corner

Here's an important Tech Tip for anyone out there with a Jag with an internal combustion engine that has motor mounts. Obviously this is everyone. Due to the inherent vibration in any gasoline engine, deterioration of the motor mounts is inevitable. Engines that leak oil onto the mounts will have an accelerated deterioration of the rubber material that is sandwiched in the mount. Replacement is inexpensive, at least for the older Jags as the mounts cost about \$20 each. The process is not too difficult as I have done this myself, and can be performed in about 2 hours. First start out by jacking up one side of the engine with a floor jack. Raise the car only enough to take the tension of the engine mount. Then carefully remove the bolts that anchor the mount to the car body. Then remove the nuts and bolts that fasten the engine to the mount. After the old mount is removed jack the engine up a little bit more to facilitate placement of the new mount. Lower the engine *slowly & carefully* making sure that all the bolts are properly aligned. Repeat on the other side of the car and the job is complete. Strangely enough, at least on the older Jag sedans, The motor mount and the bumper mounts are identical parts.
