When rebuilding wheel cylinders remember to flush out brake lines very thoroughly or replace the lines to avoid damaging the rebuilds.

Minor imperfections in the wheel cylinders can be removed by lightly sanding with 400 grit wet or dry sandpaper. Deep pits will require new liners to be fitted.

# Corner

I es you can do it. I am referring to removal of inboard rear brake cylinders without removing the entire rear axle. It is a little tedious at times but what the heck, we're all Jag owners so we should be able to tolerate it. First, elevate the rear end of the car on ramps. Remove as much dirt and grease from the rear as possible. Scrape off thick layers with a paint stick or putty knife. Always wear eye protection as dirt and grit will be present. Remove the four bolts that hold each brake cylinder to the caliper. The outer calipers are relatively easy to remove. The inner ones are the real challenge. In order to remove the left inner wheel cylinder you must first remove the tie-plate beneath the transmission pumpkin. This is simple as it is held in place with 14 bolts. The problem arises because the there is not much clearance between the brake cylinder bolts and the transmission casing. You must use a 1/4" drive ratchet on the inner brake cylinder bolts except for the left brake cylider lower bolts for which you can only use an open end or box wrench. To make matters worse you can only turn these bolts 1/8 turn at a time. Whew!!!

Once the cylinders are off, use compressed air to force the pistons out. Do this into a box with crumpled newspaper to catch brake fluid and protect the piston as it can become an unguided missle. If the fluid is dirty the cylinder walls are probably scored and the cylinder will have to be relined by a machine shop. If you are lucky and the cylinder walls are not scored the walls can be dressed with 400 or 600 wet or dry sandpaper. Clean out all traces of grit and blow out with compressed air.

The rubber seal and dust boot should also be replaced. Like brake pads, the wheel cylinder seals should be replaced per axle (all 4 brake cylinders) to provide equal breaking.

The next step is to remove the steel brake lines and inspect them. If crud comes out of the brake lines when you flush them out they should be replaced. You can buy the brake lines pre-shaped for your car or you can bend them yourself. It makes the job easier if you purchace a brake line-bending tool. If you cut the lines to fit you will also need a Let me hear from you if you decide to take the challenge. It's physically demanding (working on your back) and requires some planning but then that's what life's about.
