Tip-Top-Tech-Tips

Here's a handy tip if you are ever in a rainstorm and your windshield wipers or defogger fail. Slice an onion in half and wipe the onion juice over the windshield to increase visibility. This works almost like Rain-X in that it causes the water to form sheets rather than droplets on the windshield. To prevent the inside window from fogging, slice a potato in half and rub it on the inside of the windshield. These methods will work in a pinch. Remember that many gas stations now have convenience stores where these items can be purchased 24 hours a day.

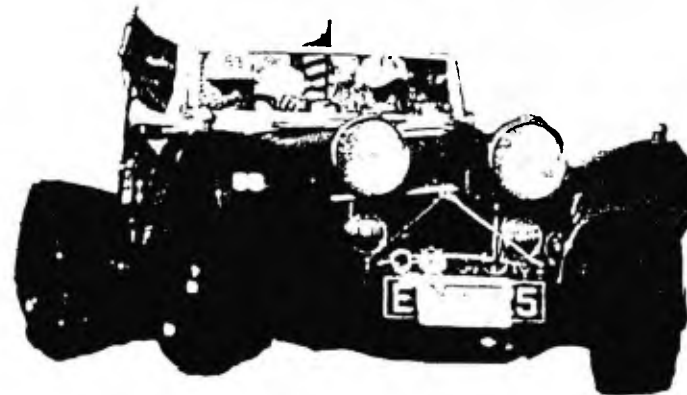

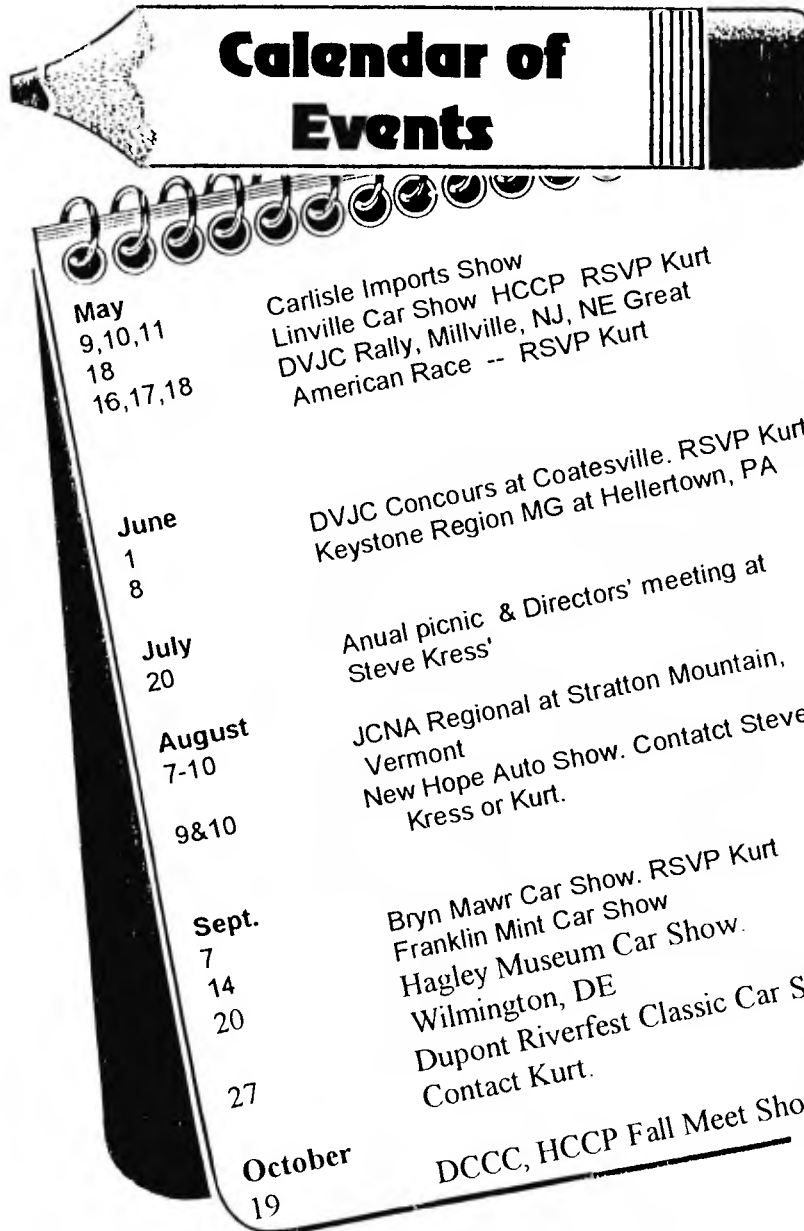
