Tip-Top-Tech-Tips

If you drive a newer *Jaguar* and have noticed that the heater blower is not working do not despair. Newer *Jaguars* have many computer-controlled devices and the blower motor is one of them. It will not function until the engine approaches its normal operating temperature. So remember to allow the car to warm up before deciding that the problem is a faulty blower motor.

On removal of the distributor from the engine block a problem may develop when re-starting the threaded bolt under the distributor. To solve this problem install a 1/4-20 stud in the block in place of the bolt. This procedure will allow you slide the distributor onto the stud instead of fumbling blindly with the bolt. Once the distributor is in place just slip a lock washer and nut on the stud and tighten the nut. Thanx to our Prez for these two handy tips!!

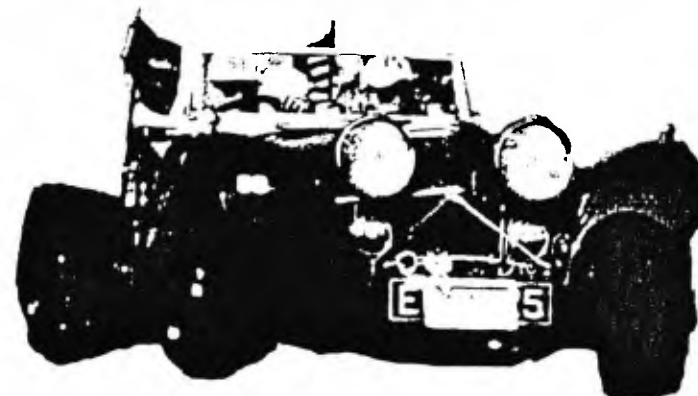
