



As this year is rapidly coming to a close, our last event, The Holiday Party, is set for December 6 at the Corinthian Yacht Club.

We have celebrated the launch of the XK120 in 1948 this year with Jaguar in a world-wide anniversary. The XK140 came along in 1954 and the XK150 started in 1957 through 1960. Specifically honored is the XK six cylinder engine which had a 38-year run, lasting until 1986 as Jaguar's basic power plant. This year our club trophies have all had the XK50 designation engraved into them.

The Covered Bridge Tour turned out well. Forty-two Jaguars showed up at Al Pincus's home and hobby barn. Al has a very nice collection of Jaguars. They're all beautiful! Al and his wife were gracious hosts with treats for everyone and freedom to roam all over the display buildings. I was happy to see so many interested members show up in their Jags, ranging from a 1952 XK120 to the new XK8. Luckily the fall foliage was still glorious, adding to the beauty of the covered bridge aspect of our tour. We spent about two hours at the Pincus home where we held a meeting to pass out maps, directions and instructions on how Jerry and Carol Schwartz had planned out the route. Our first stop was about eight miles north of the Pincus's home. We had a planned stop at a glider airport and watched several land and take off. We left there and could only drive through the last two bridges, as the size of our group started to create traffic problems in the bridge areas. We visited the Sandcastle Winery and were treated to a tasting session with a beautiful view of the Delaware River Valley in full foliage as background! 

For those Jaguar enthusiasts in the club who delve into Jaguar history, the C.J.A. had this in the July issue:

1957 and the XKSS

Jaguar had a problem in 1956 when twenty-nine D types sat, unloved in a back lot. Too many had been produced for the market to handle. Even before the last D type win at Lemans, France in June 1957, they had sold only thirteen of the cars.

The solution seemed to be turning the cars into roadgoing cars so they would be eligible for sports car races. *Jaguar* named the new machine the XKSS.

The prototype, chassis No. XKSS701, on chassis XKD555 was ready in just a few days, and on January 18, 1957 was shipped to New York as a demonstrator. The price was to

\$6900. Most of the car was still pure D type, still with no leg room for a passenger, but no driver's head rest. The "boot" trunk was filled with gas tank and the spare tire so a luggage rack would do. A fold down top had to be lowered to get at the petrol tank. The XKSS had brutal power, but was noisy and uncomfortable to drive -- and hot.

I remember hearing about the factory fire as I was serving in the Army in Germany at the time. This was February 12, 1957 and the fire destroyed some of the D types to be converted. Only eighteen were ever prepared. At the lowered price of only \$5600, they were still not easy to sell. Today a good D type will fetch \$250,000 and if one could find an XKSS, who knows what it would bring!! My preservation XKE is one of the few around that wears a luggage rack. That was the style for the XKSS, so that's why it remains on the car.






