





Tip Top Tech Tips

Ever wonder why your brakes pulse when you hit your brake pedal? I recently changed the brake pads on a late model XJ6 with 46K and found one wheel I could not get off until we resorted to extra leverage on a wrench on the form of a three-foot length of pipe. Just imagine if you had a flat tire white out on the road! It would be impossible to get the wheel off to change the tire.


I recommend wheel lugs be tightened to the proper torque. You can test this with the lug wrench provided with the Jaguar. If you cannot loosen your lug nuts with this wrench, they are on too tight. If the lug nuts are too tight, damage to your brake rotors can also result in the form of warped brake rotors. This will cause your brakes to pulse when stopping. It is also smart to carry a piece of 2X6 in your boot so that you have a base for the jack to sit on. Most dirt shoulders will allow the jack to bury itself rather than lift the Jaguar.
