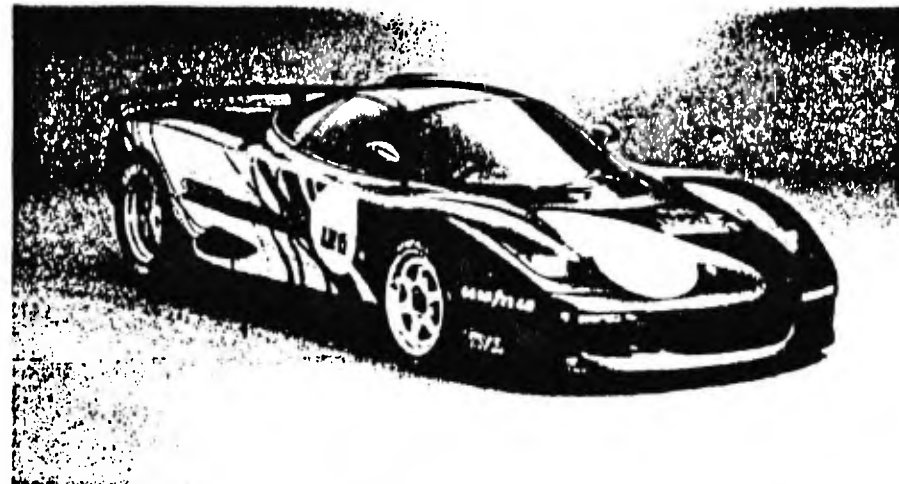

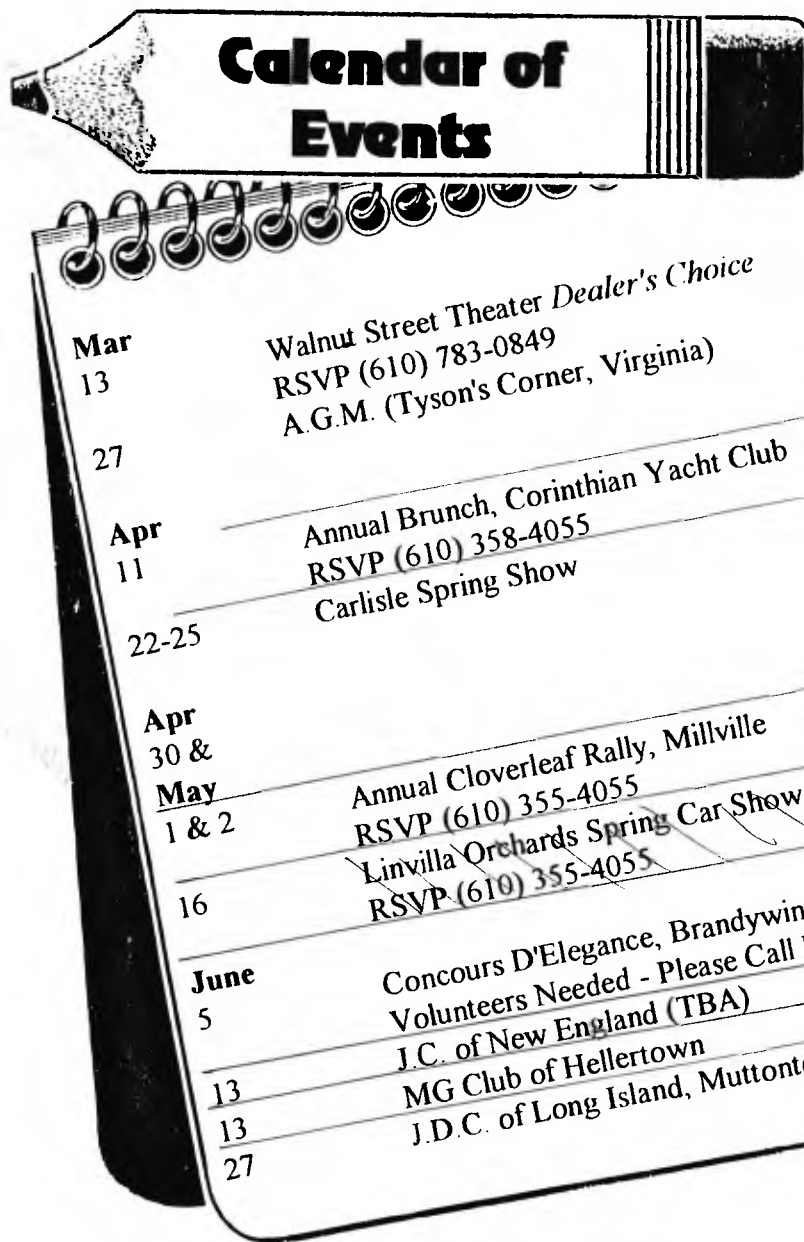

## Tip Top Tech Tips

When replacing a fan belt that has ripped apart while on the car, check other components for damage. This recently occurred on my Mark X and resulted in damage to a flexible transmission line. Over time the hose began to leak profusely. I replaced the flexible line with a stainless steel braided hose which is much more expensive, but almost indestructible.

Now is the time to check the spokes on your wheels. Tighten all loose spokes and replace any that are broken. Always remember to apply anti-seize compound to the nipple threads and the wheel splines. This will prevent rust and allow you to make proper adjustments to the nipples in the future. This grease will not melt from the splines under the temperatures produced from braking causing the wheels to become dirty.

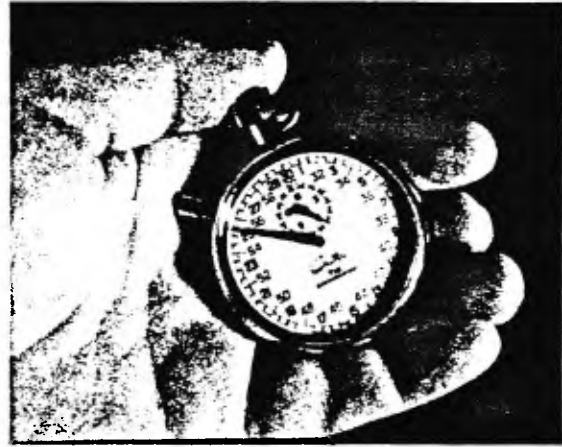
