

I must say the DuPont Country Club really is a nice place to hold a technical session with the S.A.E. group. I must also thank DVJC member Dave Harding for inviting our club to participate with his group. Dave did all the work from production of the flyer to arranging the visit of Andy Richardson who was the senior manager for vehicle packaging and analysis in the UK and was a member of the S type core team during its development. Also on hand was Kent Ellis from Jaguar headquarters in Mahwah, New Jersey. We all enjoyed the food and desserts and after that, Andy put on quite a show for us after which he fielded questions from the audience. Being familiar with laser alignment, I appreciated the portion devoted to how the drive train was installed using laser type alignment and the world class quality levels. He went on to review the safety systems, occupant

protection systems, and side impact air bag system, the Cats adaptive damping brakes, A.B.S. electronic brake distribution, and dynamic stability control.

Andy spoke quite a bit on the power train which is available. There is a 4.0 ltr V8 H.P. and a V6 3.0 ltr that produces 240 H.P. The engine blocks are produced in Cleveland, Ohio then shipped to England where the *Jaguar* heads and other associated parts are installed.





