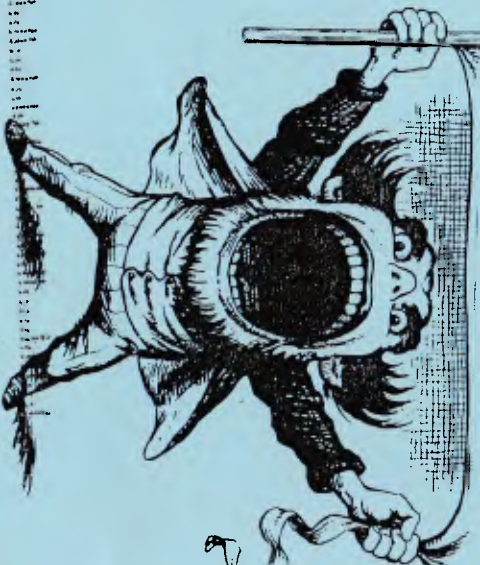

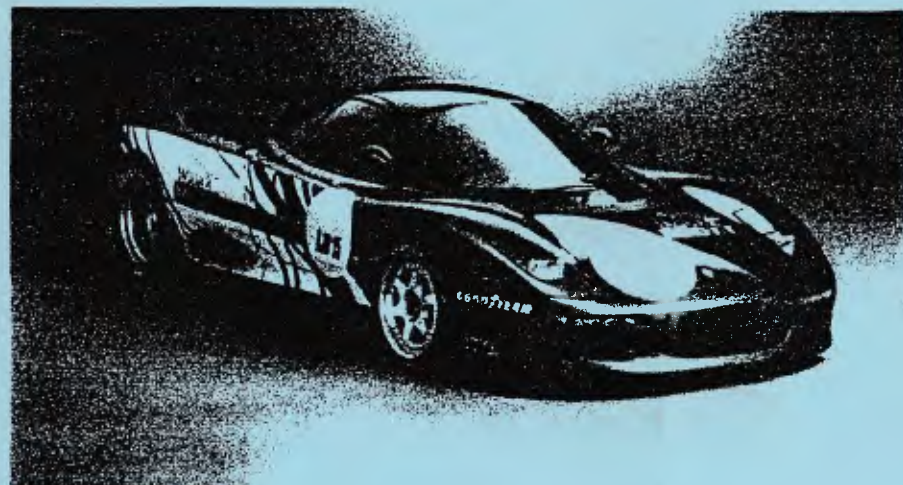

the legal issue concerning our club logo. Your club officers are all informed of this issue and hopefully, we as a club will not have to change our 35-year-old club emblem. We presently have a large stock of these emblems on hand. I have still not received the JCNA emblems which have been ordered and paid for quite some time ago.

Our mid-winter *Jaguar* tech session is scheduled for February 5th at the new Cloverleaf Auto Shop. This shop is located at 260 Bridgewater Road, Aston, PA. The subjects to be covered include *Jaguar* suspension and how to rebuild your Lucas fuel pump. In order to prepare for this event, I suggest you pick up a new diaphragm and a set of points for your spare pump and bring it along with you. I am sure most of us have a spare fuel pump or two that you would not carry with you as a spare on a trip. Are you experiencing abnormal tire wear? front or back? Well, this is what the suspension tech advice is going to address. If you notice your Pirelli P 4000s getting chewed up, it may be past the time to do those upper control arm bushings. After all, they were not designed to last forever! The new replacement bushings are made of a more superior material than the originals. This is to provide a better feel and to hold the *Jaguar* up straighter.

To locate the new shop, just pass by the old one and continue along Concord Road heading east toward Chester. The third traffic light you come to is Bridgewater Road. Turn left and proceed north 0.7 miles. The shop is attached behind Giant Concrete. From New Jersey, follow Concord Road after crossing The Barry Bridge to Bridgewater Road and turn right or north. Off Rte 95, you have to pass Concord Road and get off at Highland Avenue, then head back less than a mile to pick up Concord Road. Keep a lookout for the driveway on the left because if you go too far, you'll cross Chester Creek. Hope to see you all Saturday the 5th at 9:30! If you can't bring the *Jaguar*, just park your driver out of sight and don't tell anyone. We don't do the chicken box at tech sessions! We look forward to having some fun together. Ralph says coats and ties are not required and that

he will make the coffee and spring for the pizza at lunch!

Because this date for our tech session is so close to the planned directors meeting, we decided that it may be better to combine the two functions so that those attending would not have to drive to this area twice in two weeks.
