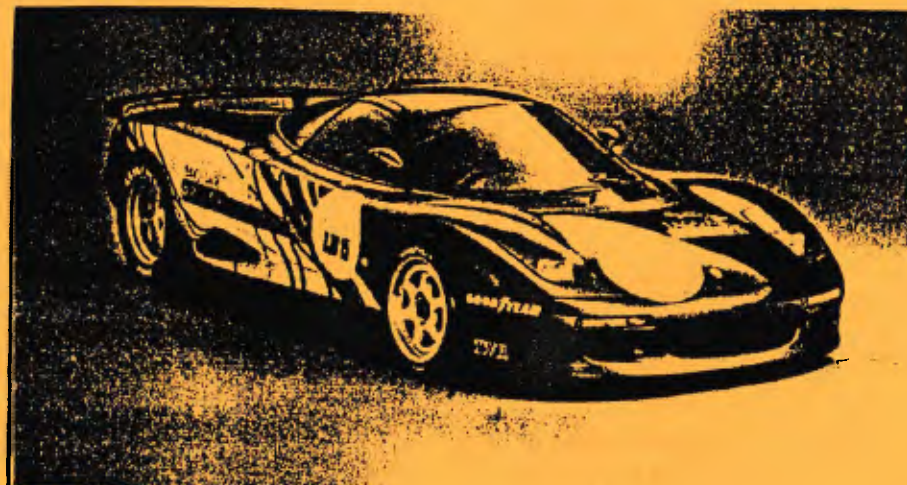

MEMORANDUM

To: JCNA Roster Maintainers
From: Nelson Rath, JCNA Treasurer
Date: June 6, 2000
Subject: United States Postal Service Change

An application has been filed with the main post office here in Louisville, KY to mail the Jaguar Journal at "periodical" postage rates in the future, (vs. the current "bulk" rate service). This will accomplish two events that are not present in the current processing of the Journal. One, there will be some postage expense reduction, but two, more importantly, the delivery time of the Journal will be sped up considerably.....instead of two-three weeks from Charlotte to California, we are expecting a first class delivery schedule of four-five days.

As part of this time consuming administrative process, the post office has required JCNA to notify EACH of its members of the following resolution:

"Resolved, that a copy of each issue of the Jaguar Journal shall be sent to each member of the Jaguar Clubs of North America and that \$12 of each member's dues of \$17 shall be for a year's subscription to that publication".
