There is lots of activity in the Jaguar world. For full detail see the following. Its exciting!!

SEE THE NEW AGGRESSIVE XJ "WOW"

The best news is the confirmation from Mike Smyth (President Great Britain's) that the replacement for the XJ8 will be released in concept form toward the end of 2008 and on sale mid-2009 and here are photos of the



beauty that will take the fight to premium rivals Audi A8, BMW 7 Series, and Mercedes S Class and beat them

at their own game. The new XJ will have many of the features described last month for the XF with high quality woods and leather plus plenty of cool blue lighting. This dramatic new look is expected to take Jaguar to new sales performance levels

The key to the new XJ's appeal is that it debuts Jaguars hybrid technology. This uses small, high power batteries to boost engine performance to help reduce fuel consumption and emissions. The photos say it has the "WOW" factor. I wonder who will restore one of these in 50 years

time or will today's collectible Jaguars still be the passion of collectors at a mini-



mum cost of \$1,000,000 a piece. Don't forget that by 2057 your new premium cars will cost about the same!!!

RECORD SALES

Sales of the revised 2008 XJ Sedan for September 2007 increased 155% and the XK Coupe 74%. The new XKR, due in salesrooms this month, had an advance sales total of 800. This news brightened the smiles of Jaguar people worldwide

NEW X-TYPE ANNOUNCED FOR 2008

A revised X-Type, with over 500 new components and the product line rationalized, will be on sale in the UK and Europe early next year. All future sedans, eight in total, will be diesels. There will be 10 versions of the Wagon/Estate only two of which will have petrol engines. When the pain of petrol cost gets enough the consumer wants diesel!!

Soon after the announcement of the revised X-Type, Jaguar said that the "X-TYPE WOULD BE WITHDRAWN FROM THE US."

We have said in the past that Jaguar lost money on every X-Type they manufactured. This must be even worse now with the current pound v \$ exchange rate. It was also debated in the past if the X-Type should be withdrawn worldwide, which actually was part of a wider discussion regarding the position the company wanted to concentrate on. It was reported in Jaguar World magazine that a Jaguar spokesperson said "We have said for sometime now that we are concentrating on the X-Type in the UK and Europe, and in particular on diesels, as well as new and emerging markets such as Russia, South Africa and Turkey. "As part of Jaguar's ongoing review over the past 18 months its North American operation has undergone a review of its marketing operations and started to reposition the brand and redefine its role in the automotive luxury market. As a consequence of this process Jaguar will cease X-Type production for the North American market in December"

"The decision was taken after extensive consultation with dealers – who have struggled to sell Jaguar's "small" car, but the prolonged strength of the pound against the US dollar was a major contributing factor" Well my wife has her X-Type Wagon which I guess will become a rarity in the USA. I wonder how many X-Type Wagons we have in the club. Please let me know if you have one. We must press JCNA to create a special class for the Concours

SO WHO IS GOING TO WIN THE BID-DING FOR JAGUAR/LAND ROVER

"THE BIDS ARE IN!" says Jaguar World magazine. "THIS RACE MAY BE TATA'S TO LOSE" says the December 3rd edition of Business Week. So the saga of the future of these two premium brands is coming to a close. You have to seriously wonder, after Ford has at last given both companies the opportunity to design and promote eye catching and desirable products, why they want to sell them. But the same could be said of Aston Martin but sell them they did. The reason we know is that the company badly needs the money though, having got this, what are they left with for the future?. They have declared that they will keep Volvo, but so far they have not declared the future of a bunch of ordinary American market vehicles. Both the above magazines believe that Ford will announce the winner before or just after Christmas. This follows the expiration of the October 29th deadline for firm bids to be lodged.

The finalists, as we have previously said, include several private equity firms, notably One Equity Partners, TPG, and Ripplewood all advised by former Ford and Jaguar executives respectively, Bod Dover, Sir Nick Scheele, and Jacques Nasser. Also One Equity Partners has just recruited Wolfgang Reitzle who managed Ford's Premier Automotive Group from 1999 to 2002. Also in the hunt is Indian Company Mahindra, primarily a maker of tractors, who recently joined forces with a US private equity company, Apollo Management, to strengthen financing for its bid. However, the emerging favorite is Tate Group of India, which is backed by Fiat. It is said that Tata is more interested in Land Rover but Fiat, as owners of Ferrari and

Maserati, have a good understanding of luxury brands such as Jaguar. Jaguar World says it is rumored that a considerable number of Tata engineers are already working at the land Rover facility.

Ford is looking to make \$2 billion from the sale. Tata has the resources to win the bidding war with \$36 billion in assets. It is said that Tata's bid is \$1 billion above those of other contenders. They have the advantage of a strong Rupee against a weak dollar. Also they are the only car company bidding and Jaguar and Land Rover are too small to survive on their own. Tata produces 400,000 vehicles a year whereas Land Rover produces 200,000 and Jaguar 70,000. It has increased sales and profits at many of its acquisitions including truck maker Daewoo in Korea.

It seems to me that whoever wins, they have the opportunity of reaping the benefits that Ford has created by pumping more than \$10 billion into Jaguar, which has modernized outdated factories, increased productivity, and increased reliability. During the next 24 months I am sure Jaguar will emerge and once again take on the mantle of its former glory. Look how Rolls Royce and Bentley prospered under new management
