

The Prez SezMarch 2009



With the **Annual General Meeting (AGM)** a little over two weeks away Kurt and I are busy with a variety of tasks in preparation. Last month I mentioned the issue of allowing trailered vehicles to compete in the Driven Division. A proposal to modify that change will be an issue to be voted upon at this coming AGM. If you were a Concours entrant I wondered about your opinion.

The Major Rule Rule Changes for the delegates to vote on are as follows:

The current By-law involving the location of an affiliate hosting an AGM must be submitted 2 years in advance for approval, be changed to, "It is recommended, but not required that the location be determined two years in advance." The rationale being, not many clubs can commit to hosting an AGM two years in advance.

The other change regards **Proxies given to a Delegate** from another Affiliate to represent them. Last year one Delegate had 22 Proxies and controlled a significant voting block. It was argued that its difficult to know what is best for the delegate's own affiliate, let alone several others. If I as your delegate were given a proxy to vote for another affiliate, I would want to know how they wanted me to vote.

The Item of **Trailering a Jaguar to a Concours to compete in the Driven Division,** has caused so much discussion, not only with the rule but the legality of its passage. The proposal this year is to allow for certain Driven Division entries to be trailered. It had acknowledged the safety and distance for vehicles older than 1974 be trailered to an event when, for the owner, that might be the only option for their participation. It was the thinking behind passing the rule last year, but lacked the language to make it acceptable to those who felt it was an unfair advantage. It's proposed to be in effect for 2009 if a 2/3 approval is given.

There are other rule changes proposed for a JCNA Concours Division and the most salient involves "Display Only" Vehicles. The proposal is to change the wording from "Display Only" to "Enthusiast Division." Some felt that it would encourage more participation.

Before I vote on any of these issues I listen to the arguments presented and decide how they affect our Club and the JCNA in general. Then use my experience and judgment on how to vote!

For those of you who want to review these issues and proposals, go the **website** <u>www.jcna.com</u>.Click on **(JCNA)** and once on that page, click onto **AGM** in the info bar and scroll down to **AGM proposals & Agenda.** If you have an opinion on how you would like me to vote on any of these issues, please contact me or Kurt Rappold. Our e-mail address is <u>cwolson29@comcast.net</u> or <u>kprappoldxksp@verizon.net</u>.

You will also see the Registration form and Flyer for our Concours at the Oakbourne Mansion near West Chester, Pa. That means I'll be asking for your help shortly for a variety of tasks. Please give me your support. **Volunteers are welcome.**

I'm planning **Judges Training in April**, to review **judging rule changes approved at the AGM.** The date and location will be in the next Purr. It bears repeating that in addition to the Judges training -- I'm setting up an **event for our new members** and those interested in entering a Concours, on how to prepare your car for Judging and selecting the Division appropriate for you. It will be informative and social in nature with an opportunity for lunch. It will also be a chance to express your interest in having our Directors plan events of your choice, for this year and beyond!

Now let's not forget the Event that is planned for the end of the Month on **Sunday**, **March 29th** at the **Sime-one Foundation Auto Museum.**, located near the Philadelphia Int'l Airport. Easy to reach and plenty of free parking. We'll be treated to a personal tour by Dr. Simeone himself! Checkout the Flyer in the back pages and send your check to Mike Tate as soon as you can! **Don't miss this great event, its just three weeks away!**

I'll report on the AGM results upon my return and look forward to seeing you at the Simeone Auto Museum at the end of the Month.



NEW SUPERCHARGED XF FASTEST JAG-UAR EVER

Secret Speed Trials at the legendry Bonneville Salt Flats in Utah, an XFR prototype recorded a stunning top speed of 225.675 MPH making it the fastest Jaguar ever. The supercharged XFR was introduced to the US market at the Detroit Auto Show in January. The Speed Trial Car, powered by the all new AJ-V8 Gen 111 engine beat Jaguar's speed record of 217.1 MPH set in the XJ 220 in 1992. The driver was Paul Gentilozzi the owner of Rocketsport Racing. High speed runs are part of Jaguar history. It is the 60th anniversary of the Jaguar XK 120's record breaking 132.6 MPH run set in May 1949 on a deserted stretch of motorway near Jabbeke in Bel-



gium.


MORE GOOD NEWS




