Last week **Kurt Rappold** and our membership director, **Ann Perry**, drove out to Indianapolis Indiana to attend the Annual General Meeting, normally referred to as the AGM. Unfortunately circumstances prevented me from attending, but Ann went as a delegate in my place and did an excellent job. As I mentioned last month, the agenda items were posted on the JCNA website and now, if you click on that website and then AGM, you can see all the results.

I think it's always good to know your JCNA officers. The website that I mentioned gives a variety of information r.e. sanctioned and other events that are scheduled by other regions. Most are within driving distance and less than 200 miles. Which reminds me to mention the **Susquehanna Valley Jaguar Club** is having their Concours the week before ours. The Flyer will be inserted in the next issue, however, Concours are static "clean and shine" events that are scheduled after a lot of events to blow the dust off doin' some driving (that's what Jags were made for ya know).

The Northeast Rally Club (NERC) has made it official with an application for those of you that wish to try it for free on April 30th. I'm sending my registration for the "Friday Only Event" but I'm going to need a "rookie navigator" to qualify! I'm looking for a volunteer to pick up Friday morning and return Friday evening. If you're considering, please give me a call and I'll provide the details. The flyer is inserted in this issue.

The next task is for **Chief Judge Kurt Rappold** and me to arrange training classes to **certify judges**. The JCNA rules state a certified judge must be acquainted with the JCNA rule book issued by the Jaguar Concours Rules Committee (JCRC). Each year at the AGM the delegates vote to accept or reject these changes. Kurt and I need to go through the rule book and add those changes. Then we'll establish a date for a Judges Training class to disseminate the new rules. We'll be contacting former judges and as many new people as are interested in learning to become a judge.

One of the approaches I'm going to attempt this year is pre-assigning of judges to a specific Division and Class. This will be done shortly after the training class when we've established the number and experience of the judges we've certified. The ideal situation the morning of the Concours is to have all your judges pre-assigned, based on the registration of the entrants. Of course, even with pre-assigning judges you will have some that don't arrive on time, or at all. Then you have entrants that arrive that day and want to register. We'll register them as a display car if they appear to have a show car quality! Since Display cars are not judged it doesn't provide a problem.

Perhaps the most difficult task confronting me presently, is to obtain a volunteer to assist our Editorial staff in Publishing our monthly newsletter "The Jaguar's Purr".

Michelle Meehan's business and family obligations have restricted her time to continue as the full time Editor and she has relinquished that responsibility to me, Brian Craig and Mike Tate. Michelle's name will appear as Editor to provide continuity of communication and logistical support until a new Editor is appointed.

The new Editor will have a staff to support and provide assistance to assemble, publish and disseminate the monthly newsletter in a timely fashion. Basic computer skills are less important than imagination in selecting and arranging the material provided.

Unintentional Exotics

Car and Driver.com said the following in February. "Occasionally, mundane cars sell in such small numbers that they become de facto "exotics" This wagon is rarer than Bentley's \$189,095 Continental Gt......Jaguar X - Type wagon. Being slightly more attractive than the X-type sedan didn't help its sales. Years Sold 2005 – 2008. Units sold in US only 1602. Well to my knowledge we have two of them in the club. Also Car and Driver don't have it quite right. Jaguar introduced the wagon but did not promote it and in fact for some of the years they say it was available very few were available. The reason for Jaguars luke warm promotion was that they lost money on every one sold. 4X4 drive, complete leather interior cost money. I take exception to their word "mundane". We continually have people saying "It's beautiful. I wish I knew that Jag made a wagon like that I would have got one." In addition Jag Main Line tell me they can't get used ones to satisfy the de-

A Serious Error Of Judgement

My piece last month, the content about my seven Jags, being the only thing I could think of as the Jag world was very quiet, had one error. It should have said eight Jags. I forgot that one summer day we were driving on the 202 heading north to New Hope when we came to the crossroads where, on the left hand side, there are always used cars for sale. This day I spotted a Series 1 XJ. Now I should known better but I stopped. The XJ did not look too bad so I took it for a run and \$4,000 changed hands and I took it home. From then on I poured endless money into it. It was in a shop near Great Britain's in Willow Grove. I took my Majestic in for service and on my way home went to see how the XJ was progressing. I have probably told this tale before but it worth repeating. I left Great Britain's and had gone about a mile when the Majestic started to shudder and pulled to the right side. Imagine my surprise when I saw the passenger side wheel go rolling down the road. It went toward the oncoming traffic, rolled between the cars to the other side of the road, turned and came back into the middle of the road where it did a circle and lay down!! Amazing it did not hit anyone as it was not just rolling but bouncing!!! My car meanwhile had dived to the side of the road and ground to a halt. It is surprising how far a car can travel on three wheels. I went to retrieve the wheel and the police drew up. "What do you think you are doing?" said the officer. So I told him "collecting wheels from the middle of the road. It's my hobby" He kindly took me back to Great Britain's who were mortified at events. Obviously the mechanic had not put the lug nuts back on the wheel! I understand it was used by management as an example of what can happen if great care is not taken. It could have caused a very nasty accident. I later received flowers for my wife, a vintage bottle of wine and a gift voucher for a meal for 2 at the William Penn Inn.

I have digressed from the XJ 8. It never did come good and languished outside my barn for the winter. Paul Racette made me an offer for it which I gladly accepted. To my surprise it started and pouring out clouds of smoke and backfiring he drove it home. During the course of the year he stripped it down but gave up when the amount of rust became too much. Just think the first XJ 8 in 1968 was a major breakthrough for Jaguar and for large sedans and set the standard to which no competitor could compare. Now the covers are off the new XJ and first drives are being hailed worldwide. 54 models were assembled in Paris for the worlds press to drive. The verdict was unanimous ... a new standard has been set again...Lexus, BMW, Mercedes are not in the same class...the XJ8 is the standard by which all others will be judged. A quote from Auto-Week says " Drive of Jaguar XJ super-sedan proves it competes world's elite" They continue " From behind the wheel, it's a whole other animal than its primary competitors, which Jaguar lists as as the Mercedes Benz-S-class, the BMW7 - series, the Audi A8 and the Lexus LS 460. It's still just sporty, not a sports car, but you could compare it with the Maserati Quattroporte, the Porsche Panamera and the Aston Martin Rapide in driving character more so than with larger sedans. The XJ has more interior room than the Maserati and the Aston Martin. But while it has plenty of sporting credibility, the elegant lines of this car will be what draws most buyers to it.


