Leonia N.J., July 17th. - Jaguar Cars, Six--month Production & Sales Record 22,049 sedans and high performance sport cars in the first six months of this year. The increase of 1,864 units over last year represents a 9.2 percent rise and keeps the company well on target to produce a record of 42,000 cars in 1986.

Once again North America was the leading market for Jaguar Cars with a record of 12,451 of which 11,506 were sold in the U.S. (up 23%) and 549 in Canada (up 58%).

Leonia N.J., Aug. 4th. - Jaguar Cars Report Record July U.S. Sales.

Retail sales of Jaguar Cars in the U.S. reached record levels for the month of July. 2,143 compared with 1,784 in July 1985 (up 22.9%)

Leonia N.J., Aug 18th. - Jaguar plc Reports Increased Six-months Revenues and Income.

Jaguar plc today reported record revenue & income for the first six months of 1986.

Revenue £ 426.2 million compared to £ 400.9 in 1985  
Profit (before tax) £ 67.4 million versus £ 63.0 in 1985

According to Sir John Egan, Chairman & Chief Executive of Jaguar "The company continues its policy of investing in the future. Research and development costs grew to £ 16 million compared with £ 13 million in the first half of 1985. Capital expenditures on facilities and new technology £ 32 million vs £ 16 million in 1985. All of these expenditures contribute toward the building of a sound base on which to secure Jaguar's future prosperity."

Both cars will be in action at Elkhart Lake, Wisconsin for the August 24 Lowenbrau 500. The Jaguar XJR-7s are built and campaigned by Group 44, Inc. of Winchester, Virginia. Crew chief for the team is Lanky Foushee while Brian Krem and Grant Weaver serve as car chiefs.

The 14th stop on the 1986 International Motor Sports Association's (IMSA) Camel GT series will feature the GT prototypes competing in the 500-mile battle, as well as the Camel Light, GTO and GTU divisions.
