JAGUAR NEWS. SUMMARY

JAGUAR CARS LTD. TO COLLABORATE WITH SEIBU GROUP IN JAPANESE SALES DRIVE

Leonia, N.J., Nov. 25, 1986 -- Jaguar Cars Ltd. is to join with Seibu Department Stores Ltd., one of Japan's leading retail organizations, to form Jaguar Japan, a company which will be responsible for the sales and service of Jaguar cars in Japan. The new company will come into operation in the Spring of 1987 when Jaguar plans to make its new range of sedans available on the Japanese market.

JAGUAR REPORTS RECORD NOVEMBER U.S. SALES

Leonia, N.J., Dec. 3, 1986 -- Total Jaguar sales for the month of November, 1986, were 1,829, compared with 1,530 in November 1985.

JAGUAR RAISES SEDAN PRICES

Leonia, N.J., Nov. 28, 1986 -- Effective December 1, 1986, prices of 1987 model Jaguar XJ6 and Vanden Plas will be increased by approximately 3.3% and 3.5% respectively. The new suggested retail prices will be \$37,500 for the XJ6 and \$41,500 for the Vanden Plas. Prices of other models remain the same.

JAGUAR REPORTS RECORD 1986 PRODUCTION

Leonia, N.J., Dec. 29, 1986 -- Jaguar, the Coventry, UK-based luxury car manufacturer, today reported that 1986 unit production had reached 41,437 cars, up 8% over 1985's 38,500, and the third consecutive year of such record results. During the year, Jaguar manufactured 32,385 four-door sedans and 9,052 XJ-S sports cars.

JAGUAR U.S. SALES SETS RECORD

Leonia, N.J., Jan. 7, 1987 -- Retail sales of Jaguar luxury cars in the United States hit a record high of 24,464 in 1986, the fifth consecutive record year. Jaguar sales in the United States were 20,528 in 1985.

According to Graham W. Whitehead, president of Jaguar Cars Inc.: "This excellent performance is due to availability from the U.K., and to our company-wide dedication to customer service and the successful dealer development program here in the U.S."
