FROM THE DIRECTOR'S CHAIR

COMMUNICATION IS A TWO-WAY STREET

RUNNING A SUCCESSFUL JAGUAR CLUB PRESENTS MANY PROBLEMS, NOT THE LEAST OF WHICH IS KEEPING EVERYBODY INFORMED AS TO WHAT'S GOING ON. WE MAKE AMBITIOUS PLANS, AND WE RELY ON A HIGH PERCENTAGE OF PARTICIPATION TO MAKE EACH EVENT A SUCCESS. WE MAKE A CONTINUING AND CONCERTED EFFORT TO KEEP ALL OUR MEMBERS ADVISED ON COMING EVENTS, THROUGH ANNOUNCEMENTS AT MEETINGS, THROUGH THE "SCRATCHING POST", AND THROUGH SPECIAL MAILINGS. ALL OF WHICH INVOLVES CONSIDERABLE EFFORT ON THE FART OF SEVERAL CLUB OFFICERS. WE DON'T ALWAYS DO AS GOOD A JOB AS WE'D LIKE TO, AND IN A FEW UNFORTUNATE CASES, WORD ON SPECIAL EVENTS HAS REACHED SOME MEMBERS AFTER THE FACT. SO IN THE END WEHAVE A GOOD TURNOUT AND A GOOD TIME - BUT EACH OF US INVOLVED IN THE PLANNING HAS A FEW MORE GREY HAIRS.

IT BOILS DOWN TO EACH OF YOU MAKING ONE PHONE CALL, OR THREE OR FOUR OF US MAKING A DOZEN OR SO CALLS. SO WON'T YOU JOIN THE SPCJCO (SOCIETY FOR THE PREVENTION OF CRUELTY TO JAGUAR CLUB OFFICIALS)?
