WOULD YOU BELIEVE THAT MY OLD AND BATTERED BUT FRESHLY REBUILT XK-140MC

WAS THE ONLY ENTRY FROM PHILADEL PHIA? THE EMPIRE PEOPLE DIDN'T!! TWO ENTRIES FROM FLEMINGTON, N.J., TOM FOREMAN IN A BORROWED FERRARI, AND TONY BODINE IN A HIGHLY MODIFIED XK-120, WERE THOUGHT TO BE REPRESENTING US, AND THE ERROR WASN'T DISCOVERED UNTIL THE VICTORY BANQUET ON SUNDAY WHEN THE AWARDS WERE BEING MADE!
